Summary including concerns/issues/discussions:

Kale Dailey presented review copies of the conceptual site plan for Lemon Bay. The plan was developed by consensus of the construction committee who met with the architect and provided input to the design. While the plan shows building locations, detail related to classroom design and interior lay out have not been developed.

Of significance is the location of a 3 story classroom building which could be started with minimal impact to the existing campus. With the exception of the auditorium, the entire campus will be renovated. Challenges to the design included providing for adequate parking. The School Board will conduct a workshop during the next month to discuss funding and phasing. It is hoped that the current seniors will "turn dirt" before graduation.

Infrastructure improvements would start the project followed by the 3 story classroom building. The project will likely be completed in 5 – 8 phases, some running concurrent.

Mr. Jeffers highlighted the Lemon Bay Marching Band's trip to the Orange Bowl. The students represented the school extremely well and except for a little sickness on the way home, had an incident free trip.

The drama department will be taking "Modern Millie" to state competition. The show has been accepted for main stage and will be performed twice. This is a huge honor and great recognition for Mrs. Kelly's program and LBHS.

ROTC annual inspections were held and the group came through with flying colors and great press. Congratulations to those students and instructors.

FCAT reading preparation was discussed. 9th grade teachers have been analyzing their students' 8th grade reading scores. This data has been reviewed with the students to make them aware of areas in need of improvement. Students have been setting goals and parents have been asked to sign their student's goal statements.

The 9th Grade Academy has been continuing the push for success. In addition to academics, the Academy's computer lab and administrative office were completed today. Space will accommodate guidance, a dean and a secretary as well as provide a conference room for meetings.

1st semester data indicates 9th graders attendance is improved over their 8th grade attendance. Referrals are also down over last year but the failure rate is of concern.

Mr. Jeffers informed the committee that the start dates for the two adopted calendars for next year would be August 20 without repeal or August 13 if the State repeals the legislation prohibiting school from starting more than 14 days before Labor Day. The semester break will be after the new year if school starts August 20.

The committee was reminded of the bus trip leaving LBHS at 11:00AM, January 30, to visit a high school in Collier County. All interested SAC members are invited to attend.

Joann moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:59. Florence seconded the motion.
