Summary including concerns/issues/discussions:

The meeting started at 7:02 PM. Members and guests were asked to sign in. (copy attached). A motion was made by Dave and seconded by Colin to approve the minutes of September 20, 2006. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Jeffers provided an update regarding the homecoming dance. The event this year was incident free. Past years issues were avoided by precluding non-students from attending, however, LBHS alumni under the age of 21 were permitted to attend as a guest of a student. 43 of the 833 attendees were alumni. In summary of the other high schools, Charlotte's dance was open and 101 of their 1,000 attendees were guests, Port Charlotte closed their dance to students only and had 700 in attendance.

Deterrents implemented at Lemon Bay included random visual inspection inside cars, law enforcement at the entrance to the parking lot, and id requirements at the door. The same policies will be applied during prom.

Mr. Jeffers informed the SAC that a Code Red drill would be implemented at the school on October 19, 2006.

All staff and students have been advised that the drill will take place. Later in the year an unannounced Code Red drill will occur. Code Red requires a lock down of campus. This means that all exterior gates will be closed to prevent vehicles from coming on campus and classroom doors will be locked until the all clear (Code Green) is issued. Other codes include Code Yellow which is for a bomb threat and Code Blue which is a call to administrators and staff that there is an incident reported yet to be confirmed. Charlotte High issued a Code Red recently as gun shots were heard near their campus. Lemon Bay came very close to issuing a Code Red when an armed robbery occurred at the Taco Bell on 776. The suspect was caught which precluded the action.

Mr. Jeffers reported on the MRSA situation affecting students from the football team. This staff infection is highly contagious and typically gets started with an abrasion. It is difficult to treat as it is resistant to common antibiotics. The school has implemented measures to stop future outbreaks. An outside contractor was hired to clean the school and the district has cleaned the other high schools as well as a precaution. 7 cases have been confirmed mostly on elbows and knees.

Mr. Jeffers reported that the auditorium would be getting much need stage curtains and landscape maintenance. The curtains cost \$60,000 due to the fire rating required and may be in place this fall. An outside firm will be hired for landscape maintenance for both Lemon Bay's auditorium and CPAC at Charlotte High.

A campus cleanup day will happen from 8:00AM to noon on October 28. All are invited to attend. Campus areas will be adopted by clubs and civic groups in an effort to improve the appearance of the campus.

Mr. Louden provided an update on the Freshman Academy. The data for the first grading period is being compiled. Referrals are way down compared with a year ago. Tutoring has begun on Tuesdays and Thursdays. 12-20 students have been showing up each night.

A \$40,000 grant was announced for Freshman Academy teacher training. This will enable the group to attend workshops to improve the program. This weekend a group will be going to Orlando to learn more about freshman transition programs. In November the staff will be trained in flexible scheduling and differentiated instruction. Later in the year staff will visit other schools with successful Freshman Academies.

Mr. Louden reported that the architect is meeting with staff groups to incorporate their suggestions into the school design. An opportunity will be provided to community representatives including SAC in the near future. This meeting will be advertised and all SAC members will be notified. It is hoped that the preliminary design will be done by mid November and that construction can start next fall.

Kale reported that the SLP was accepted and approved by the School Board. They were very complimentary of the consistency of format and quality of work produced by all school writing teams.

Kale and Mr. Jeffers attended SAC training recently. Kale indicated that LBHS is doing everything right and is an example for other SACs. We do need to revisit the bylaws and a committee was formed. Andy will chair, Carol and Teri have volunteered to assist.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:06 PM (motion by Jim, 2nd by Colin)
