Summary including concerns/issues/discussions:

The meeting opened at 7:05 PM. A sign in sheet was circulated (copy attached).

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of January 18, 2006. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Jeffers provided the Principal's report. The actual dates for FCAT testing should be February 27th and February 28th. The Manta Messenger reported the dates to be in March. NTI calling will be made to make parents aware of the correct dates.

Mr. Jeffers presented a video and follow up information on the six (6) components of **how schools are graded**. Students must be enrolled in school both October and February to be counted as **eligible** students participating in testing. 95% of eligible students must be tested in order for a school to receive a grade of A, 90% of eligible students must be tested in order to receive a grade of B. The six (6) components are the following:

1). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students scoring 3 or above on FCAT reading.

- 2). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students scoring 3 or above on FCAT math.
- 3). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students scoring 3.5 or above on Florida Writes.
- 4). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students that make annual learning gains in reading.
Learning gains include:
 - a). moving from level 1 to level 2 or from level 2 to level 3.
 - b). stayed steady at level 3, 4 or 5.
 - c). years worth of growth.
- 5). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students that make annual learning gains in math.
- 6). One (1) point for every percentage of eligible students in the lowest 25% that make annual learning gains in reading.

It was noted that Lemon Bay is a B school.

Mr. Jeffers noted that all students at level 1 or level 2 are in a reading program. Next year teachers will be required by the state to have a reading endorsement (300 hours of instruction). Three teachers at Lemon Bay have completed the requirements and three more will be completed next year.

Marcia Loudon informed the committee that on March 19th Dr. Peter Pappas will be speaking at Sun Coast Auditorium. He is the head of the model school conference and will be speaking on "what is changing in schools".

Mrs. Loudon spoke about FCAT testing February 27th and February 28th. For 10th graders, they will have two (2) 80 minute blocks for testing in reading and two (2) 90 minutes sessions for math. Freshman will have two (2) 60 minute sessions.

The NRT testing will be March 7th for 9th and 10th graders.

Mike Loudon gave a construction update on the sport field project. They are on schedule for a completion date of April. Final grading on the field is being done, along with finalizing the electrical and irrigation. The Alumni group is looking at a Manta Ray sculpture. Dave Dignam will bring in a rendition at the next SAC meeting.

Marcia Loudon informed the committee that Manta University had a good turn out for AP parents and a small turn out for parent connect.

Mrs. Loudon asked if SAC would like to pilot a new program, Web Wise Kids. This program is in response to "My Space.com" a site used by students country wide. There have been problems with students posting provocative pictures and personal information on this site that predators can obtain. Mrs. Loudon passed out the following documents: Katie's story, current internet facts, tips for parents, internet safety tips for kids, how to check your computers history and internet safety plan. Copies of documents attached. There will be two hands on training sessions, March 8th and April 5th at 7:00 PM. We will meet in the library and then move to the computers.

Mrs. Loudon asked that we view "Myspace.com" before attending the session.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
