Summary including concerns/issues/discussions:

The minutes of the November meeting were approved. Dave Dignam made the motion to accept and Joann DeQuarto seconded.

Kale Dailey provided an update from the construction committee. Revised designs for the school envision an easily securable campus which retains a courtyard. Current discussions include switching the locations of the gym and cafeteria. The first phase would likely be a 3 story instructional building where the current tennis courts, pool and weight room are.

Mr. Jeffers announced a big thank you to Berlin Sign, the Dignams and many others for the new sign on the edge of the pond. This project was done with donations, cost over \$15,000 and has 180 feet of neon in the Manta Ray alone. Thank You.

Passing Florida writes is a requirement for graduation. The students are continuing to practice sample writing across curriculums and learning how to score these samples. The writing program implemented by Lemon Bay last year has been adopted across the County. This year's freshman will have to score a 3.5 or better to pass. Florida Writes is formula writing for competency.

Mr. Jeffers commented that as the holiday break approaches, it is a challenge to keep the students focused on academics. More teachers have been attending staff development on activities such as differentiated instruction. SAC dollars continue to support this professional development. The only negative is too many substitutes.

Ms. Harvey discussed the upcoming deadlines for "senior packets" for scholarships. With two weeks left, only 30 have been submitted. Seniors are not eligible for scholarships without a completed packet. Letters of recommendation are required and students need to allow enough lead time to accommodate.

The revised bylaws were presented to the committee. The change to Article IV, Section 1 to include "representatives of the community at large" was unanimously accepted.

Mr. Jeffers informed the committee that the School Board had adopted two calendars for next year. The first would be consistent with the new State law prohibiting school from starting more than 14 days before Labor Day. It would additionally be aligned with Sarasota County. The second will be used if, as some expect, the law is repealed prior to the beginning of the year. A final calendar will be decided on during April.

There will be a bus trip leaving LBHS at 11:00AM, January 30, to visit a high school in Collier County. All interested SAC members are invited to attend.

Kathie Russo moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:47. Everyone seconded.
